2. A photo of the giant dahlia's contest
3. A photo of a the fiddling contest
4. A photo of the giant pumpkin contest
5. A photo of the 21 foot tall TOWER OF SQUASH
6. A photo of a guinea fowl
7. A photo of a swan
8. A photo of a chicken
9. A photo of a food booth
10. A photo of a farmer
11. A photo of an animal other than poultry
12. A photo of a commercial business
13. A photo of an ice cream vendor
14. A photo of your whole team with a farmer. Find out the farmers name.
15. A photo of the bee exhibit
16. A photo of tomatoes
17. A photo of some seed packages
18. A photo of the kids field games (Tuesday: human wheelbarrow and crab walk race) and (Wednesday: Potato sack and 3 legged race)
19. A sculpture or work of art made from vegetables
20. A photo of an interesting shaped vegetable

You will upload all of these photos into one google doc. **Title each photo with a description of what the photo contains, include the names of people you photograph. Include the names of the food and livestock you photograph.** Be certain that all of the names of your group are listed on the Google Doc and shared with **all** of your teachers.

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Assignment is worth 20 points, in all of your core classes.
